mind and memory I give and declare this my last will and testament  
And as for my estate as I am now possessor of I do limit by same to be  
disposed of as followeth And first whereas I by my said Antegny Barham before  
and Testament in writing and by my said Antegny Barham before  
my said wife Elizabeth full and sole executrix as by her will and Testament  
wherein several sums of money goods and chattels are due to me by my said Antegny  
Barham by and from several persons here in England; None of which is my intent  
and true meaning of me by my said Antegny and by her will and Testament that all such  
goods and commodities as I by my said Antegny have bought or contracted for with any  
person or persons by covenant or otherwise shall be conveyed and sent over into Virginia  
aforesaid unto my said loving wife to be by her disposed of according to my said  
will here by me made And as touching and concerning my said two hundred  
twenty five pounds and ten shillings to me due and owing by Mr Thomas Dyer in  
last by my said Elizabeth and whereas I by my said Elizabeth by my will  
in substance the date thereof I will that one hundred pounds thereof in ready  
money shall be assigned and sent over unto my said loving wife for the use  
and behoof of my daughter Elizabeth To be payed unto my said daughter  
Elizabeth according to the intent and true meaning of my said last will and Testament  
by me made in Virginia aforesaid And the rest of my said two hundred twenty  
five pounds and ten shillings I will and desire that my said several legacies hereafter  
mentioned may be satisfied and payed out of my said remainder to my said several  
persons and persons hereunder named Item I give and bequeath unto my mother  
Bermet five pounds of lawful money of England Item I give and bequeath  
unto my brother in law Sir John Bermet five like pounds of like  
money Item I give unto my sister Mrs Mary Dule five like pounds of like  
money Item I give unto my sister Graces five like pounds of like  
money Item I give unto my loving friend Edward Maier five like pounds
